INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Assemble and paint the model.
- 2 Cut each decal from the sheet of waterslide paper. Trim the paper and thus the carrier film to the edge of the decal, then soak the decal in warm water until the decal is released from the backing paper.
 - Note there should be no dark green surround visible when the decal is removed from that sheet of paper.
 - 3 Apply each decal in the position shown in the diagrams below.
 - Note Two numberplate options plus variations on the yellow body stripes are supplied.
 - 4 Remove all excess water or setting solution with the bristles of a paint brush, then leave the decals to dry thoroughly.
